Welcome to our summer newsletter. We have an exciting and action-packed term ahead of us. Our history topic this term is all about **World War Two.** As well as looking at the reasons behind **World War Two, life in Britain during the war and the experiences of evacuees,** we will be focusing on the significance of Droxford in the planning of the **D-day** landings. As part of this topic, we will be immersing the children in life as an evacuee and taking a trip on the Watercress line!

Our art and DT topics are also linked to World War Two. We will be designing and building our wooden and cardboard **blitz boxes** which will also light up! In music, we will be creating music inspired by WWII.



In English, we will be writing diaries and postcards based on the life of a **WWII** soldier and looking at newspaper articles. We will then be studying the text, **A Firework Maker's** Daughter by Phillip Pullman, focusing on narrative writing.

In science, we will be carrying out exciting investigations based around **states of matter** and how materials can be changed. In PE we will make the most of the (hopefully) warmer weather and will be outside honing our **athletics and striking and fielding skills**. Our RE themes are **messages and symbols** and in PDL we will be focusing on **health and well-being**.
