



Autumn Term Curriculum

Year 3/4 Cycle B

Equipping our children with the knowledge and skills to navigate life successfully.



English

Scaredy Squirrel: We will look at this text together and discuss making choices. We will write persuasive letters and diary entries.

Portal Stories: We will look at a range of books that explore other worlds and complete some descriptive and narrative writing.

History

Stone Age

We will focus on hunter gathers and early farmers as well as looking at Stonehenge, Skara Brae the Celts and the lives of Julius Caesar and Boudicca.

Music

Pentatonic Scale

We will learn the pentatonic scale, perform and compose pieces using it and notice how it can change the mood.

Maths

Year 3: Place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division – all using up to 3 digit numbers

Year 4: Place value, addition, subtraction, multiplication and division – all using up to 4 digit numbers

All children will learn new mathematical concepts, practise procedures and apply in a range of real life contexts.
