Please ensure the coach is able to reverse into the car park. If the coach is running early or late we will keep you updated via Class Dojo.

MEDICINES

All medicines should be handed to Mrs Fowler with instructions on Monday morning. Please alert her to any travel medication already taken and/or required before they leave on Friday. We will not be taking inhalers etc. from school so will need medicine that is normally kept at home for the week.

KIT LIST

A copy of the kit list is attached. Can I take this opportunity to remind you and your child that mobile phones or hand held games consoles etc. will not be needed. However, please pack books or magazines for those odd spare moments.

I would like to confirm that you will need to provide a sleeping bag, a single mattress bottom sheet and a pillow with pillowcase.

Calshot Spit is very exposed, so the children need lots of thin layers to keep warm. Thermals are a great if you have them.



SWEETS

We would like to ask that children do not bring any sweets or snacks. The reasons behind this are that Calshot provides 3 good meals a day, plus other snacks/fruit. Snacks in bedrooms become a problem at bedtime when children become hyper, stopping themselves and their room mates from much needed sleep. It can also lead to sickness in the night when they don't know when to stop.
