

Children have a day full of activities. The children need to come in wearing non-school uniform.


To wear...

- Children should wear **non-uniform**.
- They should wear a pair of trainers which will stay dry when shoreside.
- When they arrive, they need to arrive wearing their swimming costume underneath their clothes. This will save time later!

To bring...

- A labelled and generous packed lunch in a day bag.
- Labelled liquid refreshments to last the day.
- Labelled **snacks** for the day.
- A towel to keep warm after being in the water (they will have to shower at home.)
- Wet shoes or spare old trainers which will get muddy and soaked. They should wear a another pair of trainers to wear when dry/shoreside.
- Any necessary, **named medications**.






