The purpose of the Droxford Junior School FODS Lottery is to raise funds. The money raised will be paid into the FODS bank account and used to meet appropriate funding requests from the school, as well as extra equipment, resources and enrichment opportunities for the pupils.

## Terms & Conditions

- 1. The FODS Lottery is a small society lottery (Winchester City Council Lottery Registration Number LOTTERY43 22/01146) and is open to anyone aged 18 or over.
- 2. For a cost of £2.50 per ticket you will be allocated one number (chosen by us at random). Tickets can also be bought in multiples.
- 3. Payments must be made via bank transfer or standing order and payments must be received by 12<sup>th</sup> of each month in order to participate in that month's lottery
- 4. A draw will be made every month with one prize of £50 each month.
- 5. No refunds will be given once payment has been made.
- 6. The draw will be made using the online Random Number Generator <u>https://www.gigacalculator.com/calculators/random-number-generator.php</u> and will be witnessed by two members of the FODS Committee/staff from Droxford Junior School on the 14<sup>th</sup> of each month, or if that is not possible at the closest convenient opportunity (e.g. the August draw will be made in the first week back in September).
- 7. Winners will be notified within a week of the draw via the email address given on their membership form.
- 8. The prize money will be returned via BACS transfer to the winning ticket's bank account details within one week of the draw
- 9. The name and number for each month's winner will be made available through the usual school communications (if they have consented to this on the membership form)
- 10. The Lottery will be run by FODS in accordance with guidelines from Winchester City Council. In case of any dispute the decision of the FODS Committee is final. The committee has the power to amend or revoke these rules at their discretion, and will provide reasonable notice of changes where necessary.
