EASTER FAIR

We are getting ready for the **Easter Fair on Thursday 28 March which runs after school from 3:30pm to 5pm**. This is the last day of term before the Easter holidays. The Fair will be run by the children and it allows them to be really creative in planning and running their own fundraising stalls!

Children can volunteer to run a stall or game. They may want to use the theme of Easter e.g. to sell spring plants, homemade sweets, Easter cards/decorations or run games such as 'Find the Easter Chick', 'Count the Easter Eggs', 'Hook an Easter Bunny' or other games that they think will be popular.

FODS will give each stall a 'float' (£4 in small change to start you off). To make this easy can we ask that you charge at your stall in 20p's or 50p's. Remember a pot for takings.

If you are selling something, consider what you are selling (NO NUT BASED PRODUCTS PLEASE) and prices. If it is a game, consider entry prices and prizes. There is the practical side of getting things to school so keep it simple.

Jarbola - The children will have the opportunity to buy a jar from the Jarbola stall at the Easter Fair. This is a good opportunity to reuse any of those plastic toys hanging around in bedrooms and / or put in an interesting surprise or two for the lucky winner. Sweets must be pre-wrapped and remember no nut products, including jars used (which must be thoroughly cleaned). Children can bring them in now and they will be stored in a safe place. The Learning Base with the most filled jars brought in by Tuesday 26th March will win a class prize!

If your child would like to run a stall or game, please complete this <u>Stall Booking Link</u> by <u>Thursday 21 March</u>. You should automatically receive a confirmation email when the form is successfully submitted. FODS and/or Ms Barnett will direct stallholders to your stall on the day of the fair when you arrive.

Parents of stallholders can come at 3:00pm to help their child set up and stay at the end to clear up at 5pm. All stalls need an adult to supervise and help pack up after.

There will be no register taken at the end of the fair. <u>Please</u> ensure that children are made aware of their end of school travel arrangements - either going home as normal, staying on with a parent, or taking the bus home at 3:30pm.
