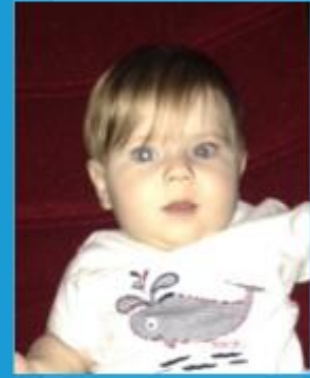




OUR story



At 5 months old we noticed our son, Seb had developed a squint where his right eye turned outwards. Just before his diagnosis we noticed a white reflection in his eye. In October 2016 we were told that Seb (9 months old) had bilateral retinoblastoma, eye cancer in both eyes.

After a combination of chemotherapy treatments Seb's tumours became 'stable' and he has been stable since 2018!

The Childhood Eye Cancer Trust (CHECT) provide support for families of children with retinoblastoma.

Support includes:

- regular face to face chats on check-up days
- setting up and managing social media groups for parents
- phone calls
- organising weekend and day trips to spend time with other families
- funding research



They continue to work tirelessly to raise awareness of retinoblastoma to help ensure early diagnosis to help save lives, eyes and sight.
