

FODS Monthly Lottery Terms & Conditions (updated 19th May 2026)

1. Promoter

The lottery is promoted and operated by:

Friends of Droxford School and is a registered Small Society Lottery with Winchester City Council under the Gambling Act 2005 (Registration Number: LOTTERY43 22/01146)

Registered Address: Droxford Junior School, Union Lane, Droxford SO32 3QR

2. Purpose of the Lottery

The purpose of this lottery is to raise funds to support Droxford Junior School, including (but not limited to) educational resources, school trips, enrichment activities, and equipment for pupils. All proceeds are used solely for the benefit of the school.

3. Eligibility

The lottery is open to parents, guardians, staff, and supporters aged 18 or over

Tickets must not be sold to or held on behalf of persons under 18

The Promoter reserves the right to refuse or cancel entries that do not meet eligibility requirements

4. Entry and Tickets

Tickets cost £2.50 per entry per month and participants may purchase multiple entries per month

Entry is confirmed once payment has been received in full

Entries may be made via: standing order (bank transfer), or online payment platform (where applicable)

5. Subscription (Recurring Entries)

Where participants choose to pay via standing order or recurring payment:

Entries will automatically be included in each monthly draw while payments remain active

It is the participant's responsibility to cancel payments if they wish to withdraw

6. Draw Details

Draws take place monthly and winners are selected using a randomised process

The draw will be conducted fairly and independently by the Promoter or an authorised representative.

7. Prizes

The prize amount is £50 per draw

8. Notification of Winners

Winners will be notified using the contact details provided to FODS Lottery

Where contact cannot be made within a reasonable time, the Promoter reserves the right to redraw or reallocate the prize

The name of each month's winner will be made available through the usual school communications (if they have consented to this)

9. Payment & Administration

Payments are collected and processed securely via approved banking or payment systems

The Promoter is not responsible for bank errors or incorrect payment references supplied by participants

10. Data Protection (GDPR)

Personal data is collected solely for the administration of the lottery

Data will be stored securely and used only for lottery purposes, including payment processing, draw administration, and winner notification

Data will not be sold or shared with third parties for marketing purposes

Participants may request access to or deletion of their data in accordance with GDPR regulations.

11. Cancellation

Participants may cancel their entry at any time by:

Cancelling their standing order, or by notifying FODS in writing/email

Cancellations will take effect from the next draw cycle where possible.

12. Liability

FODS accepts no liability for:

- Technical or banking errors affecting entry payments
- Lost or delayed communications outside its control

13. Changes to the Lottery

The Promoter reserves the right to:

- Amend these Terms & Conditions
- Change prize structures or draw procedures

Any significant changes will be communicated to participants in advance where reasonably possible.

14. Gambling Compliance

This lottery is registered as a Small Society Lottery under the Gambling Act 2005 and is operated in accordance with the requirements of the Gambling Commission and local authority regulations.
