Dear Parents,

Thank you for booking a place for your child on the Calshot 2026 trip, and for paying a deposit and/or balance via Arbor. Your child's place on the Calshot 2026 residential is confirmed.

TRIP COST

Based on the number of pupils attending, the final cost of the visit (including your paid deposit) is £434.72* and includes return travel by coach, full board, 4 nights' accommodation and a full programme of fun activities.

*Children who are entitled to the Targeted FSM funding will have 50% of the trip paid for.

FINAL BALANCE

Following your paid deposit of £100, the final balance of £334.72* may be paid via Arbor – 'Calshot 2026 Final Balance' (or by way of cash at the school office) by Monday 2nd November 2026. This amount may be paid in instalments up until the final deadline.

The Williams Collins Charity

This charity was set up in the seventeenth century in Corhampton to provide for the education of children in the parish. The original endowment now provides an annual income, which is managed by local people and can provide financial help towards the cost of residentials.

Applicants must live within the parish boundaries of Corhampton, Meonstoke, Droxford or Exton and provide evidence of financial need. If your child does not live in the parish boundaries, the governors may be able to support families who may be experiencing financial difficulties.

KIT LIST

A copy of the kit list is attached. Please may I take this opportunity to remind you and your child that mobile phones or hand-held games consoles etc. will not be needed. However, please pack books or magazines for those odd spare moments.

I would like to confirm that you will need to provide a sleeping bag, a single mattress sheet and a pillow with pillowcase (as per the attached kit list).

Calshot Spit is very exposed, so the children need lots of thin layers to keep warm. Thermals are a great if you have them.

MEDICAL FORM

All pupils attending must have a completed medical form before attending the residential. A medical form will be sent out to you for completion in the new academic year.
